These are number of innovative practices introduced by the college in the last four years.

Although Nalanda is known for preserving and imparting the classical dance forms in the most traditional manner, it has always welcome modern trends. The training of classical Dance requires rigorous practice and traditionally the knowledge is passed on orally to the next generation, but in Nalanda the focus lies more on the academic based knowledge. As there are no standard textbooks prescribed for this

course, the students are given computerized notes. These notes have been very handy for students those who come from the vernacular medium as well as from the mofussil areas of the country. The teaching methodology in this college is more on the student- teacher interactive basis . The notes are discussed in the class in detail. Over and above this the visual aids are also used in pertinent sections of the syllabus. The DVDs and VCDs are viewed for the relevant topics. Students are given assignments in the form of projects which they present in the power point programme making them Technosavvy.

Nalanda has a huge collection of archrivals' which includes video recordings of various dance maestros and gurus which are viewed by the students on the LCD. This enhances their understanding of the presentation technique.

'Nrityotsava' a National dance festival organized by Nalanda every year offers ample scope for the students to enhance their event management skills, since major part of the festival is managed by the students.

The above stated innovations have had a positive impact on the overall functioning of the institution.

#### <u>Title of the Practice – Master Class – The regular practice</u> <u>sessions for the teachers.</u>

**Goal** – Teachers are the role models for the students. Nalanda Nritya Kala Mahavidyalaya a unique institution of its own kind in the country very much believes in the above statement. absolutely fit and toned body, with excellent command over the movements which requires continuous practice under the able guidance of the Master. Keeping this requirement in view the regular practice sessions are designed by Dr. Smt. Kanak Rele.

#### The Context-

Art has no barriers it does not see poor or rich. An artist is born with god's blessing, but to groom oneself in to becoming the artist ,he/she needs sound financial backgriound

Nalanda one of its own kind in the field of dance is a ray of hope for the artists born with lower financial background. Nalanda offers certificate, Diploma, Graduation, Post-Graduation and Doctorate courses at a very low price compare to other institution, that is the reason students from all walks of life wanting to pursue carrers in classical dance approach Nalanda. Nalanda has students coming from rural areas of the country. Inspite of some frees hip, Govt. scholarship and other

facilities, students find it difficult to pursue their dream education because Nalanda is situated in the prime locality of Mumbai and the cost of life in Mumbai is very high. Considering this fact the students who are badly in need of financial support are offered, teaching jobs in the hobby classes conducted by Nalanda Dance Research Centre for the young kids and are paid moderate remuneration

#### **Evidence of Success -**

The practice of Earn while Learn has proved successful. Number of students have been benefitted by this practice. There are 10 teachers appointed at present in these hobby classes. Out of them 5 are the students from undergraduates and post graduate courses.
